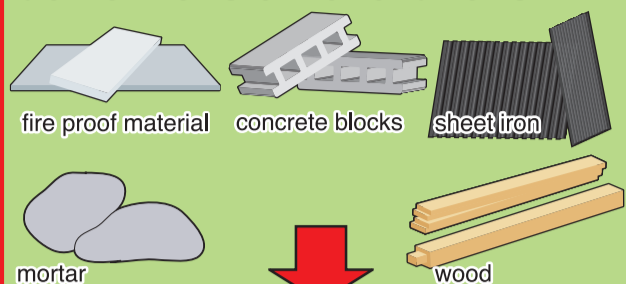

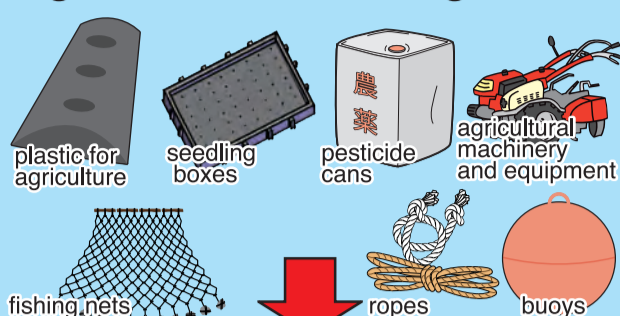

waste that occurs during house demolitions or renovations



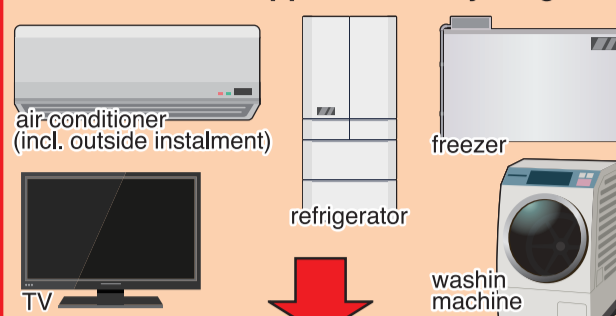
Please contact the disposal site before demolishing a house

agricultural and fishing waste



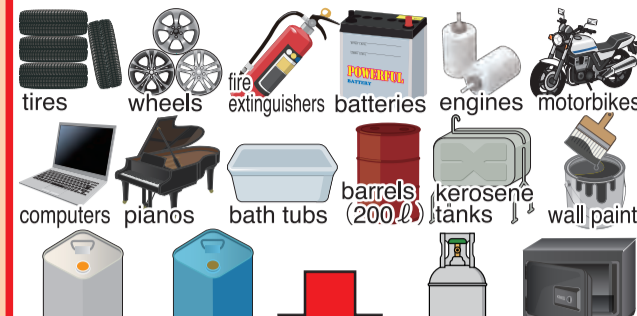
For agricultural waste, contact the agricultural cooperative;

Collectible Waste

Classification	Date	Items	Important Information
Combustibles	Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays	drain well, dirty textiles, disposable heat pads, disposable diapers (remove dirt), shoes, branches, dead leaves, cooking oil (soak up with paper or cloth), cushions, shells	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please drain kitchen waste before disposal. Please remove dirt from disposable diapers. Please soak up cooking oil with paper or cloth, or solidify with coagulant before disposal. Please remove soil from branches, roots, dead leaves, etc. If possible please break expanded polystyrene into smaller pieces. ※ Please place waste into specified garbage bag and dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Cans	Tuesdays	cans labeled with these marks (アルミ, スチール), juice, water, soy sauce, alcohol, rinse before disposal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Only cans with a maximum diameter of 10cm and a maximum length of 20.5cm are collected. Cans that exceed these measurements are collected with bulk items. Do not dispose of cans containing foreign matter such as cigarette butts. Please rinse juice cans, beer cans and food cans before disposal. ※ Please place cans in the containers at your designated local collection site.
Plastic Bottles	Tuesdays	bottles labeled with this mark (PET), remove caps, rinse and squeeze slightly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Remove caps and rinse before disposal. (Plastic caps go into "Plastic" and metallic caps go into "Non-combustibles") ※ Please place plastic bottles into specified garbage bags and dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Glass Bottles	Wednesdays	remove lids (place in "Non-combustibles"), rinse before disposal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Diameter: 3cm-12cm Length: 3cm-40cm Please remove lids and rinse before disposal. ※ Please place glass bottles in the containers at your designated local collection site.
Paper	Thursdays	paper carton, paper boxes (tissue boxes, candy packages, etc.), cardboard, newspapers, magazines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bundle drink cartons, card board, old newspapers, magazines, and paper boxes separately. Please remove aluminum foil, Styrofoam, etc. from cardboard. Please place waterproof paper into "Combustibles." Paper cartons must be rinsed, cut with scissors, laid open, dried and bound with paper string. Non-paper covers and vinyl must be removed from magazines, flyers, notebooks, notepads and booklets and bound with paper string. ※ Please dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Plastic Containers	Thursdays	plastic packaging, Styrofoam boxes, trays, plastic bags, shampoo and soap bottles, plastic containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please rinse to remove leftovers and dirt before disposal. Breakup Styrofoam boxes into smaller pieces and collect them in a bag before disposing. ※ Please place into specified garbage bag and dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Plastic Products	Every 2 nd Monday	spoons, forks, straws, pens and other stationery, toys, CDs, DVDs, VHSs etc., other objects mainly made out of plastics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> In general, if objects exceed 30 cm on any side, they should be disposed of as large-scale bulk waste. Please remove batteries from toys etc. prior to disposal. ※ Please place into specified garbage bag and dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Textiles	Every 4 th Thursday	Clothing such as jackets, suits, jeans, sweaters, jerseys, t-shirts and polo shirts, etc. (no undergarments); Cloths such as towels, sheets, etc.; Fashion accessories such as handkerchiefs, scarfs, neckties, gloves, hats, etc.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The following items are not collected: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Undergarments, uniforms (work clothes), footwear, bags, belts, accessories, bedding other than sheets, mats and carpets, dust cloths, toilet seat covers, etc. Wet or moist items. Moldy or musty items. Dirty, torn items and insect-damaged items. Cloths used by pets. (Items with animal odor) Non-collectable items, as mentioned above, can be disposed as "burnable waste". ※ Place items in specified bags, bind to prevent water damage and dispose of at your designated local collection site.
Hazardous Waste	Every 2 nd Thursday	fluorescent lights and light bulbs, lighters, empty gas cans and spray cans, batteries	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please dispose of gas cylinders and spray cans after completely using the contents, but do not remove gas by making a hole. ※ Please place in the containers at your designated local collection site.
Non-combustibles	Every 2 nd and 4 th Saturday	baby bottles, different kinds of glass, kitchen knife, crockery	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wrap sharp dangerous items with newspaper, etc. before disposal. ※ Please place in the containers at your designated local collection site.
Small-scale Bulk Waste	Every 2 nd and 4 th Friday	cameras, umbrellas, electric kettles, metal cutlery, hair dryers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Small-scale radios, telephones, tennis rackets, small electric appliances, table clocks, tools, lighting equipment, small office supplies, sporting goods (metallic items), binoculars, umbrellas, cutlery, frying pans etc. Items that do not exceed 30cm on any side ※ Please place in the containers at your designated local collection site. At "Clean Pair Hamanasu" items 1 to 28 defined in the "Act on Promotion of Recycling of Small-waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment," excluding computers, are taken from the "Small-scale Bulk Waste" for recycling.
Large-scale Bulk Waste	Every 4 th Monday (except December, January and February)	bicycles, desks, chairs, beds, suit cases	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Furniture, water heaters, screen doors, futons, chimney pipes, heaters, microwave ovens, kotatsu (tables with a heat source underneath), carpets, tatami, stereos, skis, bags / purses etc. Items that exceed 30cm on any side Please drain oil completely before disposing of items such as kerosene heaters. Please drain 18ℓ cans and remove caps before disposal. ※ If you want to throw away more than six tatami mats at once, please bring them to the Northern Kamikita Area Affairs Association "Clean Pair Hamanasu" yourself.
